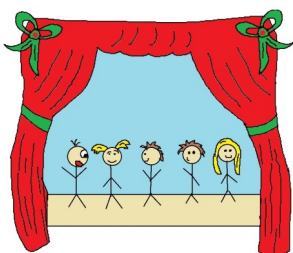

Keeping Us Safe

In order to keep our school a safe place please take note of the following:

- ◇ BASH starts at 8.15 am each morning. Please ensure children are not at school before this time.
